CALL TO ORDER and ROLL CALL

1. Resolution of Support for Bike Path Funding.

Jessica Fiester, Planning Director explained that the Town is interested in creating a multi-purpose path, a/k/a bicycle path, within the town limits down the north side of Highway 58, however that would be certain areas within the Town where the path weave through residential areas or commercial structures to proceed to the town limits at Pine Knoll Shores. She stated that this project would be constructed in phases but in order to apply for grant funding the Town would actually have to have a plan for this type of project. She noted that the NC Department of Transportation does have funds allocated for this type of project but there are specific requirements that have to be met along with a request for funding. One of such requirement is that the Town's Planning Board has to be in support in addition to the Town Council.

Miss Fiester stated that in the long range plan, Carteret County, along with three (3) other counties are working on a bicycle plan to go all around the Croatan National Forest. The plan is currently known as the Croatan Forest Bicycle Plan and included Fort Macon State Park. She did note that at this point no monies are being allotted for this project, the proposed resolution is to gain support to create a plan.

Larry Burke made a motion *to adopt* a resolution of support for a Master Bicycle Path Plan. Seconded by John Rivers. Vote was unanimous, 4-0. Motion carried.

ADJOURNMENT

There being no further action taken or business before the Planning Board, Steve Joyner made a motion *to adjourn* the meeting. Seconded by Larry Burke. Vote was unanimous, 4-0. It was 6:07 p.m.
