Town Council Special Meeting
Tuesday, June 10, 2008

A Special Meeting of the Atlantic Beach Town Council was held Tuesday, June 10, 2008 at 6:00 p.m. in the Council Meeting Room.

Members Present: Mayor A. B. Cooper, III; Mayor Pro Tem Harry Archer; Councilmembers: Ann Batt, Eddie Briley and Vada Palma

Members Absent: Councilmember Ken Ide

Others Present: Pete Allen, Town Manager; Sabrina Simpson, Administration; Marc Schulze, Public Services Director; Jessica Fiester, Planning Director and Donna Turner, Inspections Director

CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL

Mayor Cooper called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.
Mrs. Simpson took roll call.

Councilmember Briley made a motion to excuse Councilmember Ide from the meeting. Councilmember Batt seconded the motion. Vote was unanimous, 4-0. Motion carried.

OPEN SESSION

Councilmember Briley made a motion to enter into Public Hearing on Proposed FY2008-2009 Budget Ordinance 08-06-01. Councilmember Palma seconded the motion. Vote was unanimous, 4-0. Motion carried.

Mr. Wally Courie, 206 Glenn St., Atlantic Beach stated that he feels the primary concern for the town is the public accesses at Money Island Drive, specifically the two (2) six foot (6') walkways. He stated there is plankton on the left side, but the right does not have that and there are sections where the wood markings are deteriorating and the wood needs replacing. He noted the boardwalk on the east has been controversial for quite some time. He said a petition was presented to Council several years ago and now it appears to be misplaced. He would like some plankton be put in this section to prevent future easements. He also stated that the four foot (4') existing plankton cost about \$15,000.00 and he is only asking for approximately ten feet (10') to show possession.

Mayor Pro Tem Archer made a motion to exit the Public Hearing and to schedule the adoption of Proposed FY2008-2009 Budget Ordinance 08-06-01 at the regularly scheduled Atlantic Beach Town Council Meeting on June 23, 2008. Councilmember Batt seconded the motion. Vote was unanimous, 4-0. Motion carried.

Mayor Pro Tem Archer and Councilmember Briley thanked all parties involved in the creation of the proposed budget.

ADJOURNMENT

There being no further business before the Town Council, Mayor Pro Tem Archer made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Motion was seconded by Councilmember Batt. Vote was unanimous, 4-0. It was 6:24 p.m.
